What do they need to know? (content)



What platform will you use? (technology)

## What do people need to know?



### New Person - "Is this the right place for me?"

- What is Worship Like? (times, styles, sermon)
- Will this church meet my needs? (life stage, issues, gaps)
- Will I fit in? (theologically, demographics, psychographics)



### Regular Attender - "What is going on this week?"

- · What is going on? (activities and happenings)
- How do I get involved? (ways to volunteer)
- How do I stay connected? (ways to make friends)



### Active Member - "What do I need to do?"

- How do I keep up with what I need to do? (coordination)
- Why and how should I give? (giving and stewardship)

# How do I know what people want? ASK THEM


- New people Why did they start attending your church?
- Regular attenders How can we help you stay connected and involved?
- Active members What can we do to make it easier for you to grow deeper in your faith and this faith community?






## Building a content map (from scratch)

- Take the answers from your interviews and brainstorm the name of a "content chunk" for each one. PUT IT ON A POST-IT NOTE.
- As a team, silently move post-it notes into groups. Keep going until everyone silently agrees or cannot agree.
- Let each person describe their "organizing principle" for 2 minutes each.
- Work as a team to name each "group"
- Agree as a group on where "disagreements go."
- Take the key questions by group. Are the answers easy to find?





# Building a content map (steal with pride)

- Compile a list of church website that your team likes and finds easy to navigate.
- Review them as a team and ask what would work for your church.
- Build the content map of pages.




## Wix = POPULAX

#### • PROS

- A simple drag/drop editor with 500+ design options (including video backgrounds)
- Very user friendly
- Comprehensive support tools and howto videos
- Wix's patented Artificial Design Intelligence (ADI), which prompts users through a series of questions.

#### • CONS

- Does not allow users to change a template once the site is published.
- Only two-level navigation.


## Weekly = SIMPLE


#### • PROS

- Simple templated drag/drop builder.
- Many stylish design themes.
- More navigational flexibility to support a deeper, larger site.
- Provides guides to help churches with Search Engine Optimization.
- Can easily add a members-only area to their site.
- Blogging and marketing tools (social sharing, RSS, email campaigns) are more enhanced than Wix's.

#### • CONS

- Lacks the cool guided AI design of Wix.
- If a Weebly site crashes during an update, restoring it to the last live backup requires contacting their support department.






## SquareSpace = PKETTY

#### • PROS

- Best for stunning image-heavy online portfolio or brochure websites.
- Best suited for churches using an experienced web designer.

#### • CONS

- Building a site here is more technical and less intuitive than the drag/drop builds of Wix and Weebly.
- Squarespace is so customizable that the options may be overwhelming to some




## Select and Register Your Nomain

- Create a short domain that is easy to remember.
  - wapakfirst,.org vs. wapakonetafirstumc.org
  - hopecity.org vs. hopecitycommunitychurch.org
- Avoid abbreviations if possible
  - wfumc.org may be shorter but it can be harder for new people to remember.
- Try to own the .com, the .org and the .church domains
- Keep it to two or three words.


# Setup Hosting for the Website (Wordpress)

• If you choose Wordpress, you will need to find a hosting service like Bluehost or GoDaddy to host your site. They can also register your URL.




# Create a wireframe of every page

- Create a rough sketch of every page on the website.
- Look at other websites for ideas.
- Keep them simple and post them on a single wall.
- Try asking key
   questions and then see
   if you can easily find
   an answer to it.

- Search for "best 2020 church websites Wix" and find our what templates they used.
- Search for templates with your technology choice that look close to your wireframe or adapt your wireframe to look like it.
- For Wordpress, try looking on design websites like <u>https://themeforest.net/category/wordpress</u>



# Building the page content

- Define what is needed for each page (copy, pictures, etc.)
- Assign an owner for each page and ask them for:
  - Title
  - Body Copy (and suggested length)
  - Pictures
- Collect everyone's input and have ONE EDITOR put it is a consistent tone and appropriate length.
- Edit copy to reflect key words of what people will search on.



# Writing Outline for Ministry Leaders

- WHO: Who is this for?
- WHAT: What is the event, activity, etc.?
- WHEN: What is the date and time of the event?
- WHERE: Where will it be located? Be specific. Do not assume they know the location.
- HOW: How do they sign up/participate/engage? Also explain how they need to prepare, purchase, wear, etc. to make sure they feel prepared.
- WHY: Answer the question of WHY people should sign up or engage.
   Do not assume they know the answer.

## One Example: Narthall

- WHO: Dartball is open to everyone (inside or outside the church) who want to play dartball
- WHAT: Dartball is a game in which darts are thrown at a large wooden board that resembles a baseball field with colored areas which denote bases. Dartball uses baseball-like rules and scoring. First Church is part of a regional church league that plays once a week from October to April with a league championship at the end.
- WHEN: Practice on Tuesdays and play games on Thursday against different churches in the area
- WHERE: Practices in Fellowship Hall at First United Methodist Church of Wapakoneta, 504 Glynwood Road, Wapakoneta, OH 45895. Games according to schedule
- HOW: Please send an email to Jim Bowersock (<u>j\_jbowersock@bright.net</u>) or just show up at a practice or game
- WHY: Anyone can play and it is a great time to meet and fellowship with one another. We won the league championship the first year (completely by accident) and we have been terrible ever since so ALL ARE WELCOME to play.

## Turn information into a 60 word summary

## Create a longer form explanation

- Create a longer form description under 250-300 words to explain the different activities.
- This serves as fodder of a single editors to be able to build the pages.
- Also ask leaders of the activities to provide pictures as appropriate (and that you have signed photo releases for it.)



## YouTube is Your Friend

There are tons of videos to show you how to build your site, install a plug-in or configure a widget in Wordpress.



### MAKE SURE TO HAYE THE FOLLOWING:

- On the front page
  - Service Times (as one of the first things you see)
  - Address of the Church (make it highly visible)
  - Directions or Connection to Google Maps (on front page and on contact us)
  - Phone number to call for questions.
- Easy to find:
  - About Us or some introduction to the church and what you stand for.
  - What to Expect on a Sunday AM
  - What You Believe

# Final thoughts

- Be Brief you have 5 to 8 seconds to capture someone's attention.
- Keep it simple you have to maintain this site.
- Must be mobile 60%+ will use smartphones to find you.
- Keep content current Nothing is worse than showing up late because it is summer worship hours.
- Cross-link pages It helps people get around the site.
- Always keep improving The first design will never work.




