Creating a Virtual Choir Video using Movavi

- 1. Download and install Movavi at movavi.com
- 2. Have your soundtrack mp3 or 4 and all your videos together in a folder, ready to import.
- 3. Open Movavi, drag and drop videos and audio file into media bin
- 4. Pick a background and drop into the video track.
- 5. Create Title and add to Title track. If you want a photo behind your title, add a video track and drop in your photo, expanding it to be the length of your title track.
- 6. Add video track and drag a video into it from the media bin. From the tools menu, choose overlay-picture in picture. Resize and drag to chosen location. (repeat for the number of videos)
- 7. If you need to resize or crop your video's appearance, use the crop and rotate function of the tools menu. Remember that you must highlight the video track you wish to work on before you can resize or move.
- 8. Add soundtrack to the audio track
- 9. Using audio part of the videos, line up with the soundtrack to sync.
- 10. When everything is lined up nicely, do a full screen preview (from the playback menu)
- 11. When you are confident all is lined up well, delete the audio tracks from each video.
- 12. Create credits using a scrolling title track.
