## What do people need to know?



#### New Person - "Is this the right place for me?"

- What is Worship Like? (times, styles, sermon)
- Will this church meet my needs? (life stage, issues, gaps)
- Will I fit in? (theologically, demographics, psychographics)



#### Regular Attender - "What is going on this week?"

- What is going on? (activities and happenings)
- How do I get involved? (ways to volunteer)
- How do I stay connected? (ways to make friends)



#### Active Member - "What do I need to do?"


- How do I keep up with what I need to do? (coordination)
- Why and how should I give? (giving and stewardship)



# Building a content map (steal with pride)

- Compile a list of church website that your team likes and finds easy to navigate.
- Review them as a team and ask what would work for your church.
- Build the content map of pages.

### MAKE SURE TO HAYE THE FOLLOWING:

- On the front page
  - Service Times (as one of the first things you see)
  - Address of the Church (make it highly visible)
  - Directions or Connection to Google Maps (on front page and on contact us)
  - Phone number to call for questions.
- Easy to find:
  - About Us or some introduction to the church and what you stand for.
  - What to Expect on a Sunday AM
  - What You Believe




### Wix = POPULAX


#### • PROS

- A simple drag/drop editor with 500+ design options (including video backgrounds)
- Very user friendly
- Comprehensive support tools and howto videos
- Wix's patented Artificial Design Intelligence (ADI), which prompts users through a series of questions.

#### • CONS

- Does not allow users to change a template once the site is published.
- Only two-level navigation.




## Weekly = SIMPLE


#### • PROS

- Simple templated drag/drop builder.
- Many stylish design themes.
- More navigational flexibility to support a deeper, larger site.
- Provides guides to help churches with Search Engine Optimization.
- Can easily add a members-only area to their site.
- Blogging and marketing tools (social sharing, RSS, email campaigns) are more enhanced than Wix's.

#### • CONS

- Lacks the cool guided AI design of Wix.
- If a Weebly site crashes during an update, restoring it to the last live backup requires contacting their support department.
- Weebly does not have a specific church template.

### SquareSpace = PKETTY

#### • PROS

- Best for stunning image-heavy online portfolio or brochure websites.
- Best suited for churches using an experienced web designer.


#### • CONS

- Building a site here is more technical and less intuitive than the drag/drop builds of Wix and Weebly.
- Squarespace is so customizable that the options may be overwhelming to some.
- There are some non-profit templates but no specific church web templates.






## Create a wireframe of every page

- Create a rough sketch of every page on the website.
- Look at other websites for ideas.
- Keep them simple and post them on a single wall.
- Try asking key questions and then see if you can easily find an answer to it.



# Search for design template & plugins to meet your vision.

- Search for "best 2020 church websites Wix" and find our what templates they used.
- Search for templates with your technology choice that look close to your wireframe or adapt your wireframe to look like it.



## Building the page content

- Define what is needed for each page (copy, pictures, etc.)
- Assign an owner for each page and ask them for:
  - Title
  - Body Copy (and suggested length)
  - Pictures
- Collect everyone's input and have ONE EDITOR put it is a consistent tone and appropriate length.
- Edit copy to reflect key words of what people will search on.




# Help Google Find Your Website.

- Put your address everywhere on your site. Main page, footer, in even in blog posts.
- Embed a Google Map in the contact page of your website.
- Cross-link "internal" articles inside your website.
- Make sure you have a blog on your site. Post all of your newsletter articles as individuals posts and then repost on all social media sites.
- Build a communication plan to regularly post on your "hub."

There are tons of videos to show you how to build your site.



## Final thoughts about your webisite

- Be Brief you have 5 to 8 seconds to capture someone's attention.
- Keep it simple you have to maintain this site.
- Must be mobile 60%+ will use smartphones to find you.
- Keep content current Nothing is worse than showing up late because it is summer worship hours.
- Cross-link pages It helps people get around the site.
- Always keep improving The first design will never work.


## Novers Your 900gle Landscape

- Open an incognito browser.
- Start by typing in "churches near [city] [state]" both in the Google search bar and in Google Maps.
  - Try it with and without a denomination "Methodist church near [city] [state]
  - Try it without the state (since some people forget it.
- Search on your church's name (with and without city)
- Brainstorm a list of terms that people not associated with your church may search on (both church related and not).

NOW...take note what page you are on and where you rank.

  - don't include any extra spaces, the http:// or www.
  - a search of this type for Broken Sheep would look like site:brokensheep.com






Then, click Next · Sign up with your business email domain since this account will be for your chain. Enter the name of your business or chain. You can also select your chain from the suggestions that appear as you type (if applicable). 4. Enter your business' or chain's address. You may also be asked to position a marker on the location of your chain's branch on a map. If your business doesn't have a physical location but works in a service area, you can list the area instead. Then, click Next. 5. 
## How to add UEn's

- After logging in with an email not attached to your church, ask questions relevant to visitors.




### Start with Facebook


- High traffic site that fits into people's daily habits
