



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### What they need to learn



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Before you talk to any of your friends greet anyone you don't recognize (think is a quest)

## guest/visitors

- In Introduce yourself
- Out Ask the other person about themselves
- Up- Tell them something special about the church

# up with guest

- Think about how you collect personal information. Now a name and e-mail or cell phone number is fine.
- Don't worry if people do not leave information. They will leave it when they are ready.
- Connect before they leave.

# guest

- I recommend going to a worship in a different denomination (religion) in a neighborhood different than yours.
- What are the difficulties in going somewhere new you have never been?

- How do people know where to go? (sanctuary, bathroom, childcare)
- How do people know what to do?
- Are all aspects of your church welcoming or are they exclusive?
- Can they make friend there?

## demographics


- If you don't know who you are trying to attract, you need to focus.
