Liturgical Aids Online

<u>Worship words</u> – Free progressive worship resources using inclusive language . Organized by type of liturgy, scripture, lectionary, and by ritual.

<u>re:Worship</u> – This site is compilation of lots of people's work (all attributed) and it's allows searching by scripture, type of liturgy needed (prayer of confession, call to worship, litany ,etc.). It also organizes resources by date for the RCL.

<u>Reformed worship</u> – Great for ideas about seasons, themes, special services, and more. Great place to go if you want to learn more about worship, the theology behind services and seasons, fresh ideas and ancient truth.

<u>Rev-o-lution</u> – Rev. Mindi Welton-Mitchell is an American Baptist pastor whooffers calls to worship, confession/assurance, and prayers for each Sunday as well as one paragraph of meditation on both the RCL and the NL scriptures. It's a great start for those looking for connections between the different scriptures in the lectionary.

RCL Specific

- <u>Lectionary Library</u> Curated by Vanderbilt Divinity Library. Read the RCL scriptures with links to: prayers, hymns, art, colors (chart of the year), slides (yes, fully formatted slides with pictures and scripture texts you can use in worship).
- Lectionary Liturgies Rev. Thom Shuman is a PC(USA) pastor who writes for each Sunday in the RCL call to worship, opening prayer, call to reconciliation, prayer of forgiveness, assurance of pardon, prayer of dedication/offering, prayer of great thanksgiving (communion), and sending.
- <u>Uniting Church Australia</u> Archived by month and year and by category.
- <u>Worship Ways</u> Original liturgies written in English and in Spanish by United Church of Christ pastors, based on readings from the Revised Common Lectionary. Look for Sunday, festival and special UCC worship services here, organized by seasons of the Church Year.
- <u>Worship Connection</u> From the Methodist Church was discontinued in 2022 but follows the lectionary, had complete worship services. If you know the scripture you are looking for, you can search for that scripture and generally find the "worship connection" for that day, as well as articles and other helps (some behind a paywall).
- <u>Sermon Seeds</u> A preparation resource designed for use with the Revised Common Lectionary. Each week, you'll find that Sunday's Lectionary texts and a reflection on the focus text. Sermon Seeds are also adapted as "Weekly Seeds" on <u>ucc.org</u> for Bible study in the local church and for personal devotion and study. Along with the text and reflection, you'll find a prayer, additional thoughts for reflection, and focus questions for discussion.
- <u>Call to Worship Journal</u> (available to Presbyterian Association of Musicians Members \$100 annually.) This has Calls to worship, Confession – call, prayer, assurance, prayer of illumination, communion prayers, as well as other liturgy pieces for the season. It also suggests hymns, artwork, and more.

Narrative Lectionary

 <u>Narrative Lectionary Worship Resources for Year 2 (2023-2024)</u> – This is a resource created by Luther Seminary (who created the NL) with the scriptures, prayer of the day, and hymn suggestions for each Sunday in the NL. Their Working Preaching blog and podcast also provide sermon starts for each Sunday.
