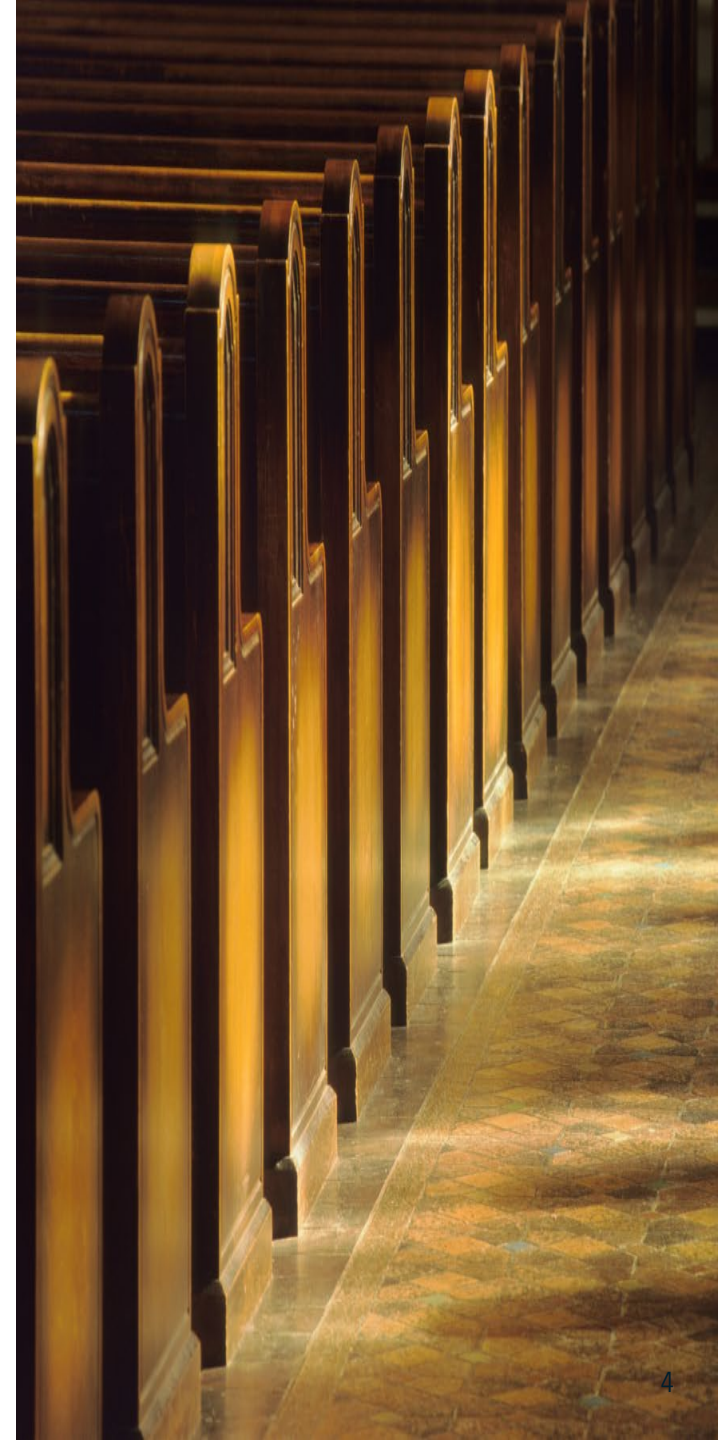

  - Postlude

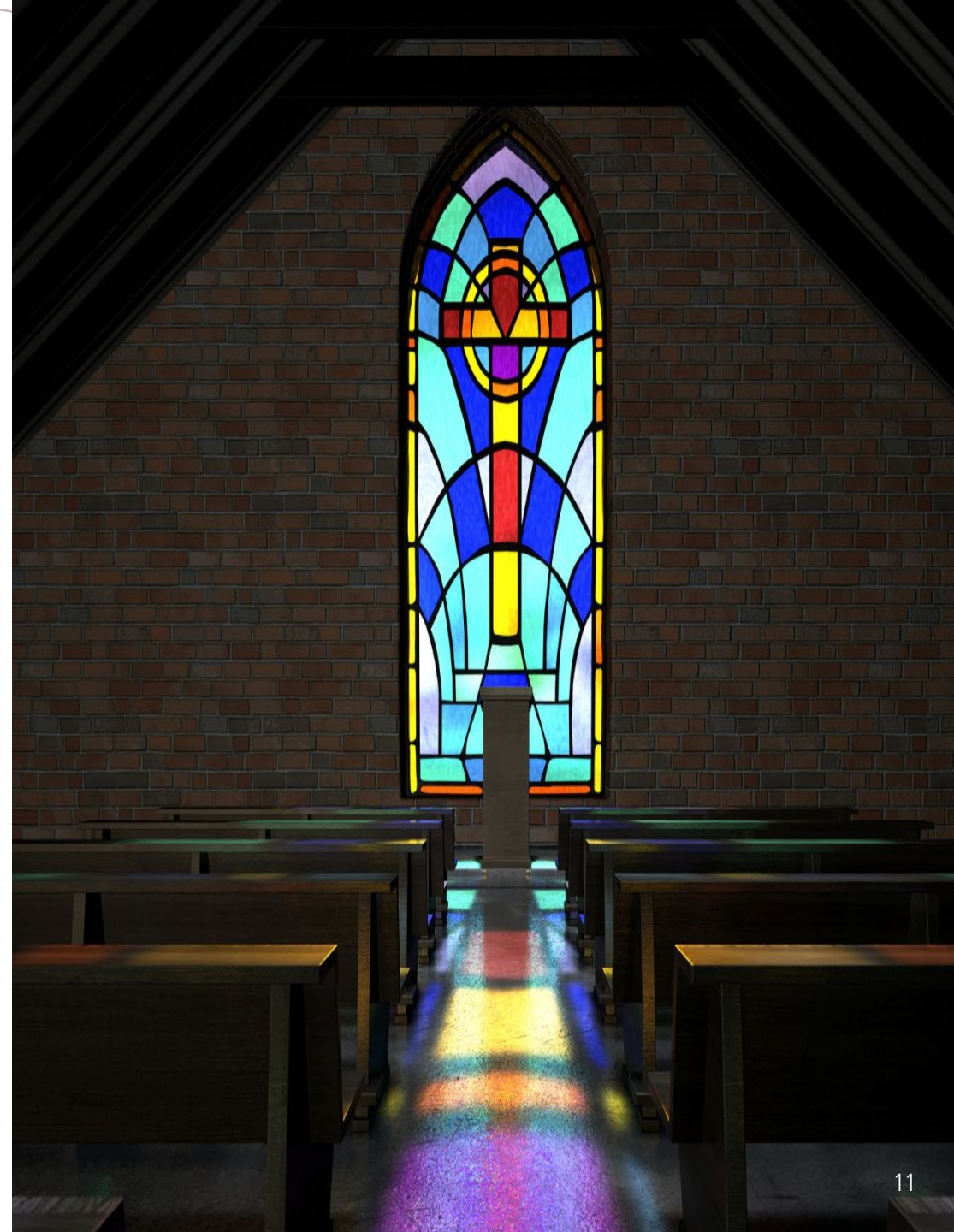
